- Children under the age of 16 cannot be accommodated in the College
- There is only one fully accessible Room.

Single Occupancy - £75.00 per room per night
Double Occupancy - £150.00 per room per night.

Twin rooms are available only for the whole length of stay – you cannot switch from a single room to a twin room for one night.
